





Step 1

Have the donor provide a specimen and return the cup to the collector.

Step 2


Replace and tighten the cap. Verify the temperature is within the range on the temperature strip. (90 - 100°F)(32 - 38°C)

Step 3

Remove the label to view the results.

Step 4


If equipped, place the adulteration card next to the adulterant strip on the cup. If any of the test pads match any of the colors on the left, adulteration is indicated.



Step 5

Read the results when all upper "Control" or "C" lines have appeared. Negative results can be read as soon as all "Test" or "T" lines are visible.

(Wait 5 minutes to determine a Positive Result)





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
